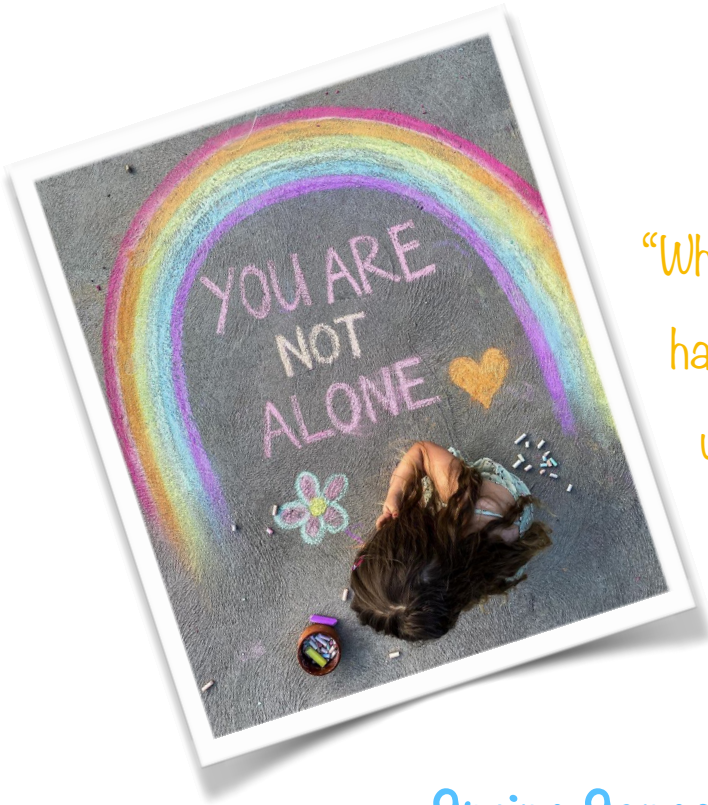


Thursday, April 2, 2020
