Tuition and the Class Supply Fees are billed through FACTS tuition billing based on the timing of enrollment and on the payment plan chosen after enrollment is secured. All fees are non-refundable.
Parent Volunteerism Enrolling your child in a Waldorf school requires parent involvement. Private education cannot exist by virtue of tuition alone; both private and public schools owe much to their large pool of parent volunteers. The parents of the Olympia Waldorf School provide consistent service to the school by helping with school fundraisers, participating in committees, assisting in the maintenance of the school grounds and buildings, supporting the festivals and attending regular classroom parent evenings throughout the school year.
