Job Openings: Substitute Teachers For school year 2018-19

We are seeking several new substitutes for all grade levels, preschool - Grade 8. Substitutes in early childhood programs work as assistants. Substitutes in grades classes (1-8) work as a primary classroom teacher. Hours vary according to need. School hours are 7:45 am to 2:45 pm.

Olympia Waldorf School is accredited through the National Council for Private School Accreditation and the Association Waldorf Schools of North America. Waldorf philosophies are an important part of the teaching and culture of the school.

The ideal person will have teaching experience, flexibility, and an enthusiasm for Waldorf Education. Employment will begin with training in mid-August.

Anyone wishing to work in preschool or kindergarten are required to comply with Dept of Early Learning requirements, including TB test, food handlers permit, early childhood training, etc. Those who only wish to work with grades 1-8 must pass a full background check and participate in first aid/CPR training.

Compensation: Compensation includes increments for relevant experience, and begins at the state minimum wage level for assistants in early childhood. Grades teachers are paid up to \$100 per day, depending on hours worked. Benefits include full remission of extended care costs while working.

Hiring Process: Qualified candidates will be invited by our Head of School to attend a substitute orientation.
