To achieve the 'spiralling' effect, the first dove needs to be tied to the ring so that it hangs 5cm (2") below the ring. The thread of each following dove needs to be about 4cm (11/2") longer. (The second dove hangs 9cm (31/2") below the ring, the third dove 13 cm (51/8") below the ring etc.) Space the doves out evenly around the ring.

Flying ricebags! and streamers!

Fun for outdoors! Twirl this little bag fast round and round. Let go and see it fly

Instructions:

Place the ends of the three strips of crêpe paper and the end of the string onto one side of one square of cotton. Place the other square on top and sew through the crêpe, string and cotton, around three and a half sides, leaving enough space to turn the bag inside out. Do this and fill with rice or beans. Sew up the opening and have fun flying!



You will need:

Two scrap pieces of cotton in a nice colour, each 10 x 10 cm (4 x 4") Rice or beans A piece of string 70cm (28") Three brightly coloured strips of crêpe paper 4 x 150cm (1½ x 60")

A variation on this are the streamers

You will need:

Three crêpe paper strips of 4 x 150cm ($1\frac{1}{2}$ x 60") 60cm (231/2") dowelling Glue
